RESOLUTION 25-2008

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE 2008 TWINSBURG
DISTRICTING COMMISSION AND APPOINTING
FIVE (5) QUALIFIED ELECTORS TO SAID
COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 3.02(B) of the Charter of the City of Twinsburg requires this Council to appoint five (5) qualified electors to constitute the 2008 Twinsburg Districting Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That there be, and there hereby is, created and convened a 2008 City of Twinsburg Districting Commission which shall consider the readjustment, apportionment and proration of registered voters as relates to the present geographical boundaries of the five (5) electoral wards of the City of Twinsburg, determined from the registration for the last statewide general election and who shall have all the powers and duties set forth in Section 3.02, Wards, of the Charter of the City of Twinsburg.

SECTION II: That the 2008 City of Twinsburg Districting Commission prepare and file with the Clerk of Council, on or before January 10, 2009, a report with its recommended plan for any adjustment of such ward boundaries, which report is to include a map and description of the wards recommended and is to be drafted as a proposed ordinance.

SECTION III: That this Council hereby appoints the five (5) following named qualified electors of this City as members of the 2008 City of Twinsburg Districting Commission:

SECTION IV: That all members of the City Administration are hereby directed to aid and cooperate with said Commission in the preparation of its report. Said Commission is empowered to call upon any City Official, at its discretion, to appear before it for aid, guidance or advice.

SECTION V: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VI: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason to have this commission in place as soon as possible, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
