ORDINANCE 21-2009

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 147.20 OF CHAPTER 147 "UNIFORM/CLOTHING ALLOWANCE" OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TWINSBURG AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration has recommended an amendment to Section 147.20 of Chapter 147 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Twinsburg; and

WHEREAS, Council recognizes that the recommended amendment is necessary for the continued efficient operation of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That Section 147.20 is hereby amended to read as follows:

147.20 UNIFORM/CLOTHING ALLOWANCE

(g) Sworn officers of the Police Department who are not members of a bargaining unit shall receive a Uniform Allowance equivalent to that of the **Patrol Officers' Collective Bargaining Agreement** bargaining unit employees. **The Police Chief and Police Lieutenants shall receive a Uniform Allowance equivalent to that of the Sergeants' Collective Bargaining Agreement. The Terminal Agency Coordinator in the Police Department shall receive a Uniform Allowance equivalent to that of the Dispatchers' Collective Bargaining Agreement.** The City shall provide uniforms for part time dispatchers and part time police in an amount to be determined at the discretion of the Police Chief and approval of the Mayor.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that it is the need of the community, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
