ORDINANCE 24-2009

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TWINSBURG, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TWINSBURG FIRE FIGHTERS LOCAL 3630 INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration has conducted extensive negotiations with the Twinsburg Fire Fighters Local 3630 International Association of Fire Fighters, as the bargaining representative for fire fighters in the City of Twinsburg Division of Fire; and

WHEREAS, public sector bargaining law in the State of the Ohio mandates that said agreement be ratified immediately by the legislative authority of the City of Twinsburg; and

WHEREAS, such negotiations have provided a tentative agreement between the parties; and

WHEREAS, said Fire Fighters Local 3630 has advised the Administration that the tentative agreement has been ratified by vote of the union membership; and

WHEREAS, Council and the Administration have reviewed the proposal and desire to ratify and adopt said Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into, on behalf of the City of Twinsburg, an agreement with the Twinsburg Fire Fighters Local 3630 International Association of Fire Fighters. A copy of said agreement is marked as "Exhibit A," attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully rewritten herein.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety

welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that in order to facilitate payment of compensation to certain employees of the City, the foregoing ordinance is required at the earliest possible time, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
