A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY,
175 SOUTH MAIN STREET, AKRON OHIO 44308,
TO PROVIDE ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City seeks to utilize the services of the County Animal Control Manager to impound, house, feed, redeem, sell, and euthanize animals found running at large within the municipality that are seized and delivered by City animal warden; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously contracted with Summit County to provide such services and said contract is expiring; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the City the contract with Summit County, Ohio, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", incorporated by references herein.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting or to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
