**RESOLUTION 6-2010**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADVANCEMENT OF LOCAL TAXES FROM THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER FOR THE TAX YEAR 2009 PAYABLE IN 2010 IN ACCORDANCE WITH O.R.C. SECTION 321.34 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Summit County Fiscal Officer has requested that local authorities request advancement of local taxes annually by Resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 15 day of December, 2009, this Council passed Resolution 179-2009 requesting the advancement of local taxes that has been amended herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the Summit County Fiscal Officer is now requesting all municipalities making such request to amend prior legislation to conform to the County's specific request.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That the City of Twinsburg hereby authorizes the advance of local taxes by the County Fiscal Office for the 2009 tax year, payable in 2010, in order to comply with Sections 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code to receive advance payment of local taxes.

**SECTION II:** That all prior Resolutions, specifically, Resolution 179 - 2009, that may be in conflict herewith be repealed upon affirmative passage of this Resolution.

**SECTION III:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION IV:** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the further reason it is necessary for the City of Twinsburg to balance the 2010 budget, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
