**RESOLUTION 10-2010**

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP) RESURFACING FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO IMPROVE CHAMBERLIN ROAD AND DECLEARING AN EMERGENCY

---

**WHEREAS**, Chamberlin Road is a urban collector; and

**WHEREAS**, this road serves the community and is integral to the transportation network to the City of Twinsburg; and

**WHEREAS**, Chamberlin Road is in need of Resurfacing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) Resurfacing Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following Resurfacing Project:

(1) Chamberlin Road Resurfacing from SR82 to Ravenna Road (skip area resurfaced with Parker Lake Estate Subdivision) at an Estimated Cost of \$560,000.

**SECTION II:** That the City of Twinsburg acknowledges and understands the AMATS “Funding Policy Guidelines” and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

**SECTION III:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION IV:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that it is to apply for this funding within the next six days, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
