**RESOLUTION 12 -2010**

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO  
THE PLANNING COMMISSION, AND DECLARING  
AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Section 7.07 of the Charter of the City of Twinsburg provides that the Planning Commission shall consist of five (5) qualified electors of the City, one member from each of the five wards, not holding another City office or appointment; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of two (2) members of said Commission expires as of January 31, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now incumbent upon this Council to appoint two members of said Commission.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That the following named qualified electors of the City of Twinsburg not holding any other municipal office or appointment be, and the same hereby are, appointed as members of the Twinsburg City Planning Commission to serve the term as the same appears below:

1. Don Picciano Jr.	1	2-1-10 through 1-31-12
2. Kolette Woloszynek	2	2-1-10 through 1-31-12

**SECTION II:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION III:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that these vacancies must be filled prior to February 1, 2010, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
