RESOLUTION 20-2010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TO
ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH INDEPENDENT
ENERGY CONSULTANTS INC FOR NATURAL GAS
AGGREGATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg is interested in reducing its energy costs by opt-in and opt-out aggregation for its residents, small businesses and city owned accounts; and

WHEREAS, Independent Energy Consultants Inc. is certified by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio and offers energy brokerage and natural gas aggregation services that may reduce the cost per energy unit consumed; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has determined that Independent Energy Consultants Inc. shall be the exclusive agent to provide the services set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor be, and she is hereby authorized to make and enter into an Agreement with INDEPENDENT ENERGY CONSULTANTS INC. in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference herein, to provide natural gas aggregation services as stipulated in said Agreement.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
