RESOLUTION 28-2009

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THREE MEMBERS TO
THE ENVIRONMENTAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION
COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Section 151.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Twinsburg provides that the Environmental Historic Preservation Commission shall consist of five qualified electors, one from each ward of the City appointed by Council; and

WHEREAS, the term of three members of said Commission expires as of January 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon Council to appoint (3) three members to fill such resulting vacancies upon said Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the following named electors of the City of Twinsburg not holding any other municipal office or appointment be, and the same hereby are appointed as members of the Twinsburg Environmental Historic Preservation Commission to serve the terms as the same appears below:

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional

reason to fill the vacancies prior to February 1, 2009, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law
