RESOLUTION 31-2009

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE 2009 CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TWINSBURG; APPOINTING THE NINE FULL VOTING MEMBERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 11.01 of the Charter of the City of Twinsburg provides that this Council shall create a Charter Review Commission on or before five (5) years after the recess of the last preceding Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That this Council, in accord with Section 11.01 of the Charter of the City of Twinsburg, hereby provides for the creation of the 2009 City of Twinsburg Charter Review commission to convene and report its studies and findings to City Council within seven (7) calendar months after such appointment. Said Commission shall be organized and shall have such membership as is provided by Charter Section 11.01 and shall perform the duties and assume the responsibilities delineated therein. Nine (9) full voting members who are qualified electors shall be appointed by Council. The meetings of said Charter Review Commission shall be open to the public. The Commission may have assigned to it by the Mayor such secretarial or clerical assistance as shall be needed to perform its duties.

SECTION II: That this Council hereby appoints the following nine (9) full voting members to the 2009 City of Twinsburg Charter Review Commission:

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Twinsburg and the inhabitants thereof, and for the additional reason that the Charter of the City of Twinsburg requires that creation of the 2009 Commission and the completion of its responsibilities are within a limited period, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
