RESOLUTION 39-2010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ORIANA HOUSE INC., A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION, TO PROVIDE AN ALCOHOL REHABILITATION FACILITY FOR CONVICTED OFFENDERS

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg is engaged in the prosecution of misdemeanor crimes involving the abuse of alcohol; and

WHEREAS, in connection with such prosecutions it is the practice and policy of the Stow Municipal Court to order, in accordance with law, participation in certain evaluation and rehabilitation programs; and

WHEREAS, the law provides that the City of Twinsburg is responsible for a portion of the cost of such sentencing programs; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the evaluation and rehabilitation programs offered by Oriana House, a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio, are suitable and appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor be and she hereby is authorized to enter into an agreement with Oriana House Inc. to provide evaluation and rehabilitation programs for certain convicted offenders, said agreement to be in substantially the form of that document attached hereto incorporated by reference herein and identified as Exhibit A.

SECTION II: The Finance Director is authorized to make disbursements from the general fund in accordance with the terms of the agreement and upon the submission of invoices approved by the Mayor.

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
