A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN EASEMENT FROM
EDWARD A. WALTERS AND KRISTEN A. WALTERS,
UNTO THE CITY OF TWINSBURG, SUMMIT
COUNTY, OHIO, FOR DRAINAGE AND SLOPE
MAINTENANCE

WHEREAS, Edward A. Walters and Kristen A. Walters have agreed to grant unto the City an easement over certain property for the purpose of managing storm water; and

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg has determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City to perform drainage and slope maintenance activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the City of Twinsburg hereby accepts a certain easement granted by Edward A. Walters and Kristen A. Walters in the City of Twinsburg relating to improving and controlling storm water runoff. Said easement bears the signature of the grantor and is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
