ORDINANCE 01-2005

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER MODIFICATION TO THE CONTRACT WITH GENERAL TREE SERVICE, 7199 HAVEMANN, CELINA, OHIO, 45822, FOR ADDITIONAL WORK RELATED TO THE 2003 CITY WIDE TREE PLANTING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg, pursuant to Ordinance 133-2003, entered into a contract with General Tree Services for the 2003 City Wide Tree Planting; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has recommended the additional work on this project; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that a modification of the contract is necessary to authorize the additional work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to agree to the modification of the contract with General Tree Services relating to the 2003 City Wide Tree Planting in an amount not to exceed \$823.00 for additional work.

SECTION II: It is determined that the aforesaid modification, including without limitation the cost of the additional work, did not substantially alter the contract, were undertaken for improvements insubstantial compliance with the original plans and specifications, and was in accordance with the original bid unit prices to the extent applicable to the modification.

SECTION III: That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay to General Tree Services in an amount not to exceed \$823.00 from Account Number 82-000-5252-50 Capital/Land & Development.

SECTION IV: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that additional work was needed for the 2003 City Wide Tree Planting, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
