ORDINANCE 04-2005

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TOM PERVANJE, AIA, TO PROVIDE ARCHITECTURAL CONSULTING SERVICES; PRESCRIBING PAYMENT THEREFOR; DECLARING IT UNNECESSARY TO SOLICIT PUBLIC BIDS THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the architectural objectives of the City of Twinsburg can best be achieved with the services of an independent, trained and experienced Architect; and

WHEREAS, the services of such Architect are necessary to continue architectural consulting services for the Architectural Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Twinsburg is authorized under the provision of §147.11 to employ on behalf of the City such special part-time, independent, contractual personnel as necessary; and

WHEREAS, the services herein authorized are unique, professional, personal services requiring skill and learning, and are recommended and required to be obtained on an emergency basis, and are thus exempt from competitive bidding provisions of the Charter of the City of Twinsburg and the laws of the State of Ohio:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Thomas J. Pervanje, AIA, for services as a Professional Architectural Consultant in accordance with the terms of a contract which shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION II: That the Finance Director be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to pay for such services on behalf of the City pursuant to the approved contract and upon proper presentation of vouchers for work accomplished at the rate provided for in said contract. Said amount shall be paid from Account Number 10-063-5234-71/ Professional Services.

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason to have architectural consulting services immediately available, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
