

**CITY OF TWINSBURG, OHIO**

**ORDINANCE 12-2005**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TWINSBURG, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TEAMSTERS LOCAL #436, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Administration has conducted extensive negotiations with Teamsters Local #436, as the bargaining representative for the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

**WHEREAS**, such negotiations have provided a tentative agreement between the parties; and

**WHEREAS**, Council and the Administration have reviewed such proposal and do desire to ratify and adopt such Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Teamsters Local #436, on behalf of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully rewritten herein, marked "Exhibit A."

**SECTION II:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION III:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that in order to facilitate payment of compensation to certain employees of the City, the foregoing ordinance is required at the earliest possible time, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
