ORDINANCE 04-2006

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TC ARCHITECTS, INC., 1650 WEST MARKET STREET, AKRON, OHIO, 44313 TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE PROPOSED FIRE STATION ON GLENWOOD DRIVE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg, requires additional architectural and engineering services; and

WHEREAS, Council and the Administration have determined that it is appropriate to retain the services of a consultant to provide architectural and engineering services; and

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in the Qualification Based Selection Process required by Ohio House Bill 231 and determined that it is appropriate to enter into an agreement with TC Architects, Inc. of Akron, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with TC Architects, Inc., 1650 West Market Street, Akron, OH 44313, to provide certain professional services to design the proposed fire station; such services to be provided and compensated in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement, which is incorporated by reference herein, attached hereto and identified as Exhibit A.

SECTION II: That the Finance Director be and she is hereby authorized to make payments to TC Architects, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Eighty Five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) and Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred (\$14,200.00) in reimbursables; such payments to be made in accordance with the terms of the agreement referred to above upon submission of invoices approved by the Mayor and to be disbursed from account number 10-061-5234-71 – Engineering Professional Services.

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that it is necessary to commence this project immediately, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
