**ORDINANCE 43-2006**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,758.60 AS THE CITY OF TWINSBURG’S CONTRIBUTION TO THE TINKERS CREEK STRESSOR STUDY TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE OHIO EPA AND THE UNITED STATES GEOLOGICAL SURVEY WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES

**WHEREAS**, the City of Twinsburg is one of seven municipalities discharging treated wastewater into Tinkers Creek; and

**WHEREAS**, the biological condition of Tinkers Creek is such that, for many years, it has not been in attainment for fish populations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio EPA and United States Geological Survey plan to conduct a study to ascertain the sources of the various biological impacts on Tinkers Creek with the objective of improving water quality; and

**WHEREAS**, total cost of the study is \$276,000.00 with Ohio Water Development Authority providing a grant in the amount of \$131,000.00 and Summit County and other participating communities providing funds in proportion with the percentage of treated waste water flow.

**WHEREAS**, it is determined that the City of Twinsburg’s proportionate share of \$78,990.00 in local municipal matching funds to be administered by the US Geological Survey is \$13,758.60.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

**SECTION I:** That the Finance Director be and she hereby is authorized to disburse to the United States Geological Survey the amount of \$13,758.60 as the City of Twinsburg’s share of the cost of the Tinkers Creek Stressor Study, said funds to be paid from Account No. 51-060-5-234-55 Sewer Professional Services.

**SECTION II:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION III:** That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
