ORDINANCE 46-2006

**AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE PUBLIC WORKS
COMMITTEE OF COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Section 7.01 Article VII of the charter of the City of Twinsburg authorizes Council to abolish certain boards or commissions; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee of Council is not presently an active committee; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon the concurrence of five members, has determined that it is appropriate to abolish the Public Works Committee of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Public Works Committee of Council be and the same is hereby abolished.

SECTION II: That any and all ordinances and/or legislative enactments inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
