RESOLUTION 19-2006

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP) FUNDS PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) TO IMPROVE HIGHLAND ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Highland Road is needed to provide a properly maintained and safe traveling surface to the public; and

WHEREAS, this road widening is important to the City of Twinsburg; and

WHEREAS, Highland Road is in need of widening.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following Highland Road widening improvement:

- (1) The total estimated project cost is \$5,707,000.00 with the anticipated split as follows:
- (2) Federal Highway Administration (STP) \$4,146,400.00
- (3) County of Summit Road & Bridge Funds \$858,300.00
- (4) City of Twinsburg \$702,300.00

SECTION II: That the City of Twinsburg acknowledges and understands the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety convenience and welfare of the City of Twinsburg and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is to apply for this funding as soon as possible, and provided that it receives the approval of two-thirds of the members of Council, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
