RESOLUTION 24-2006

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF TWINSBURG, AN AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF REMINDERVILLE, OHIO, PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING, HOUSING AND FEEDING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg has available facilities for the impounding, feeding and housing of certain animals; and

WHEREAS, the use of such facilities by the Village of Reminderville will result in savings for residents of both communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the Mayor be and she is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Village of Reminderville providing for the impounding, feeding and housing of certain animals, such agreement to be in substantially the form of that document identified as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
