RESOLUTION 32-2006

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN EASEMENT FROM DILLINGEN LTD, UNTO THE CITY OF TWINSBURG, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO, FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A SANITARY SEWER

WHEREAS, Dillingen LTD. has agreed to grant unto the City an easement over certain property for the purpose of installing and maintaining a sanitary sewer; and

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg has determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of the City to install this sanitary sewer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the City of Twinsburg hereby accepts a certain easement granted by Dillingen LTD in the City of Twinsburg relating to the installation and maintenance of a sanitary sewer. Said easement bears the signature of the grantors and is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
