ORDINANCE 04-2007

AN ORDINANCE HIRING DAVEY RESOURCE GROUP AS THE CITY FORESTER, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DAVEY RESOURCE GROUP AS THE URBAN FORESTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg requested a proposal for a City Forester; and

WHEREAS, after review, it is the recommendation of the Administration and the City Engineer to retain Davey Resource Group to be the City Forester.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That this Council does hereby hire Davey Resource Group as the City Forester.

SECTION II: That the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to enter into this agreement, at an hourly rate not to exceed \$60.00 per hour, all of which shall be approved as to legal form by the Law Director, with Davey Resource Group, for the City Forester.

SECTION III: That the cost of such services shall be as set forth in attached Exhibit "A", without further action of this Council, and the Finance Director shall cause payment to be made, as outlined in the attached Agreement.

SECTION IV: That such City Forester shall be contracted for without the necessity of advertising and soliciting of public competitive bids due to the professional nature of the services.

SECTION V: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION VI: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that the City Forester is needed for the tree program, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
