ORDINANCE 06-2007

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING CERTAIN MONEYS TO AND FROM VARIOUS ACCOUNTS AND FUNDS AS ESTABLISHED IN ORDINANCE 180-2006, THE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TWINSBURG FROM THE YEAR 2007 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to transfer certain moneys to and from various accounts and funds in order to efficiently and adequately administer the City's resources in light of financial requirements now known.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:


SECTION I: That the attached Exhibit "A" is made a part hereof by reference as if fully rewritten herein, and further that the amounts as indicated in Exhibit "A" shall be, and hereby are transferred from and to the accounts and funds therein recited, which accounts and funds have been heretofore established in Ordinance 180-2006, the Temporary Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Twinsburg for the year 2007.

SECTION II: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in open meeting or meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety welfare and convenience of the citizens of the City of Twinsburg, and for the additional reason that the transfer of moneys herein described is immediately necessary to respond adequately and efficiently to the City's financial requirements, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
