RESOLUTION 22-2007 AS AMENDED 1-23-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TWINSBURG TO REIMBURSE RESIDENTS FOR DAMAGES SUSTAINED AS A RESULT OF FLOODING INDUCED BY A SEVERE STORM EVENT ON OR ABOUT JUNE 22, 2006

WHEREAS, on or about June 22, 2006 a severe storm event occurred in the City of Twinsburg and surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the storm severe flooding occurred in specific areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Motion made at the regularly scheduled Council meeting held October 10, 2006, the majority of Council authorized the reimbursement of up to 78 residents for an amount not to exceed Forty Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$47,800.00); and

WHEREAS, the reimbursement was based upon certain guidelines set forth as follows:

1. Reimburse insured deductible up to \$1,000.00 maximum with proof of payment from the insurance agency.
2. Reimburse uninsured up to \$500.00 maximum with proof of a minimum \$500.00 expenditure.
3. The claim must have been received by City Hall prior to today's date of October 10, 2006.
4. Proof of the claim must be submitted to City Hall no later than October 20, 2006.
5. Council may change or discontinue this past practice once these reimbursements have been satisfied.
6. **Residents that were included on the original list and have provided all of the other documentation but have not as of this time signed the release will be reimbursed at the time of which the signed release is given to the City.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Twinsburg, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

SECTION I: That the City of Twinsburg is hereby authorized to reimburse sixty (60) residents in the amounts reflected in "Exhibit A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION II: That Council acknowledges that this is a unique circumstance and that its action herein shall not be construed as setting a precedent to be followed if the same or similar situation occurs in the future.

SECTION III: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitations, those set forth in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


