Proposed Language for Civil Service Rule Amendment

“XIX. POLITICAL ACTIVITIES”

(A) No officer or employee in the classified service of the **City of Twinsburg** ~~state, the several counties, cities, and city school districts of the state, or the civil service townships of the state~~ shall directly or indirectly, orally or by letter, solicit or receive, or be in any manner concerned in soliciting or receiving, any assessment, subscription, or contribution for any political party or for any candidate for public office; nor shall any person solicit directly or indirectly, orally or by letter, or be in any manner concerned in soliciting, any such assessment, contribution, or payment from any officer or employee in the classified service of the state, the several counties, cities, or city school districts of the state, or the civil service townships of the state; nor shall any officer or employee in the classified service of the **City of Twinsburg** ~~state, the several counties, cities, and city school districts of the state, or the civil service townships of the state~~ be an officer in any political organization or take part in **either (1) partisan politics or (2) nonpartisan politics with respect to political offices in the City of Twinsburg** other than to vote as the officer or employee pleases and to express freely political opinions.

For the limited purpose of preemptively avoiding a violation of the above rule concerning the prohibition on taking part in either (1) partisan politics or (2) nonpartisan politics with respect to political offices in the City of Twinsburg, an officer or employee in the classified service who seeks either (1) a partisan political office or

(2) a nonpartisan political office in the City of Twinsburg may request, but shall not be guaranteed approval of, an unpaid personal leave of absence pursuant to the terms and conditions of Section 147.23 of the Twinsburg Codified Ordinances for the duration of their candidacy. The aforementioned request for an unpaid personal leave of absence pursuant to Section 147.23 shall be requested prior to the time at which the officer or employee in the classified service declares their candidacy.
